- UACTE changed its name from Utah Vocational Association (UVA) in May 2002.
- Utah Vocational Association was organized in 1929, making UACTE one of the oldest vocational/career associations *in the country*.

- UACTE is an affiliate of ACTE. UACTE is made up of 10 divisions and one prospective division.
